Next training class starting January 9, 2018

The position as a TRUSD Bus Driver requires a High School diploma or the equivalent, the successful completion of 20 hours of classroom instruction related to the skills, regulations, and safety requirements for driving a school bus, and the successful completion of 20 hours of instruction behind the wheel of a school bus.

Once you complete the Training Program you become eligible for hire with Twin Rivers Unified School District.

Applicant Costs are as follows (all costs are approximate):

- \$57.00 CHP Application and Fingerprinting (Cash or Check)
- Medical Exam (cost varies by provider)
- TB Test (cost varies by provider)
- \$73.00 DMV Commercial Permit
- \$5.00 DMV H6 Printout (may need to provide additional copy at an additional cost)

Class Requirements:

100 % attendance is mandatory for all classes

- Registration and Orientation (2 hours)
- In class instruction (25 hours)
- CPR and First Aid Training (8 hours)
- Optional Study Session for the CHP Test (2 hours)
- Behind the Wheel Instruction (25-30 hours)

STEPS TO COMPLETE YOUR APPLICATION

Applications are available at the Twin Rivers Adult School office, the Twin Rivers District Office – Bay A reception desk, or online at www.tras.edu. Applications may not be submitted online.

Along with your completed application, bring the following to your first class on January 9, 2018:

- ❑ **Current H6 printout of your driving record.** You must have a clean driving record with the last 24 months to participate in training. This printout is not available online. You must request a printout in person at the West Sacramento DMV

- ❑ **Valid California Driver's License.**
- ❑ **Proof of your High School Diploma or GED.** Bring either your original diploma or a sealed high school transcript. If you are currently completing your high school diploma, you may provide proof of your expected completion date. You must have completed your high diploma before taking the CHP written test.
- ❑ **Social Security card.** You will need to present your social security card for fingerprinting at a later time.
